Training Women in WASH Entrepreneurship, to support the access to water and sanitation (2019-2020)

Business and employment Opportunity

- ❑ 40 women trained in WASH entrepreneurship (this group traditionally does not benefit from trainings & Cyclone Kenneth recovery)
- ❑ 5 Districts: Macomia, Mneluco, Quisssanga, Ancuabe and Metuge
- ❑ 20 WAH businesses established for 20 trained women
 - 11 on improved bath toilet construction
 - 3 drilled tube wells
 - 6 “barracas”/small shops for table top water filters sale

EDUCATION ON SANIATION AND HIGIENE

- ❑ 50 awareness campaigns on the importance of sanitation, hygiene and health
- ❑ 100 informative session on WASH in community radios
